She has won five regional Emmy awards for anchoring and covering breaking news. Her television career included jobs at CNN in Atlanta and local stations in Washington, D.C.; Dallas; and Lexington, Ky. She is also a Gracie Award winner for her work in public media.

Angela graduated from the University of Maryland, College Park, with a degree in journalism. She was inducted into the Hall of Fame at the university's Philip Merrill College of Journalism in 2024.

ST. PAUL MAYOR MELVIN CARTER > A fourth-generation Saint Paul resident, Mayor Carter leads with an unapologetic equity agenda. Since taking office in 2018, his accomplishments include raising the city's minimum wage; tripling free programs in rec centers; eliminating late fines in public libraries; reestablishing an Affordable Housing Trust Fund; expanding immigrant & refugee support resources; and launching an Office of Financial Empowerment. One signature initiative is College-Bound Saint Paul, Mayor Carter's plan to start every child born in the city with a \$50

College Savings Account, starting January 1, 2020. A proud graduate of the Saint Paul public schools, Mayor Carter holds a Bachelor's Degree in business administration from Florida A&M University and a Master of Public Policy from the Humphrey School of Public Affairs at the University of Minnesota. He resides in Saint Paul with his wife, Dr. Sakeena Futrell-Carter, and their children.



MINNEAPOLIS MAYOR JACOB FREY > Jacob Frey has served as the Mayor of Minneapolis since January 2018. Born on July 23, 1981, in Oakton, Virginia, he earned a track scholarship to the College of William & Mary, graduating with a degree in government. Frey pursued professional distance running, representing the United States at the 2007 Pan American Games. He obtained his Juris Doctor from Villanova University School of Law in 2009. After moving to Minneapolis, Frey practiced employment and civil rights law and became active in community initiatives. He was elected to the Minneapolis City Council in 2013, representing the Third Ward, before being elected mayor in 2017 and re-elected in 2021.

Hayes' work places an emphasis on enhancing policies and programs that can more effectively address the specific needs of BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and People of Color) members and communities. He resides in Saint Paul with his wife, Dr. Sakeena Futrell-Carter, and their children.

ADAM GISLASON > Specializing in intellectual property, entertainment, and business law, Adam left "Big Law" after 15+ years to pursue entrepreneurship. He is Chief Strategy Officer at VENTIVE, a custom software agency and incubator, and co-founded Strike Advisory, specializing in R&D tax credits for tech companies. He also launched KATAPOLT to provide outside counsel for music and tech companies like Dash Radio and BPM Supreme. Adam serves on the executive boards of The Sanneh Foundation and Minnesota Film & TV (co-Vice Chair) and speaks at events like SXSW. He lives in Minneapolis with his wife, Paula, their son, Sebastian, and a baby on the way.



ZACH DUCKWORTH > Zach Duckworth is a Republican Minnesota State Senator for District 57, covering Lakeville, Farmington, and parts of Dakota and Goodhue Counties. He took office on January 3, 2023, with his term ending January 5, 2027. Born in 1987, Duckworth holds a Bachelor's and MBA from the University of St. Thomas. He is a small business owner and former Chair of the Lakeville School Board. A Major in the Minnesota Army National Guard, he earned the Bronze Star Medal for his service in Kuwait and Iraq (2011-2012). He has also been activated for civil unrest in Minnesota and deployed to the Middle East during his first term.

JAY XIONG > Jay Xiong is a Democratic-Farmer-Labor (DFL) member of the Minnesota House of Representatives, representing District 67B, which includes parts of Saint Paul. He assumed office on January 8, 2019, succeeding Sheldon Johnson. A lifelong resident of Saint Paul, Xiong graduated from St. Olaf College. He co-founded the Asian American Organizing Project and Progressive Hmong American Organizers, reflecting his commitment to community engagement.

In the House, Xiong chairs the Workforce Development Finance and Policy Committee and serves on the Capital Investment and Economic Development Finance and Policy Committees. Xiong resides in Saint Paul's Battle Creek neighborhood with his spouse and children.

BOBBY JOE CHAMPION > Senator Bobby Joe Champion, a lifelong North Minneapolis resident, graduated from North High School and earned degrees in Political Science and Law from Macalester College and William Mitchell College of Law. Now a practicing attorney, he specializes in negotiation and legal analysis. His love for music led him to found "Excelsior," a Grammy-nominated choir. He also worked with Flyte Tyme Productions. Champion's legal career includes roles with Attorney General Keith Ellison and as Assistant Attorney General under Skip Humphrey and Mike Hatch. Elected to the Minnesota House in 2008, he has championed job creation, affordable housing, education, and criminal justice reform. Since 2012, he has served in the Minnesota Senate as Senate President and chairs the Senate Jobs and Economic Development Committee.

GLEN FLADEBOE > Glen Fladeboe is a principal partner at Fladeboe Advancement, a leading benefit auction and donor engagement consulting firm with nearly 25 years of experience. Raised on a farm in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, Glen's agricultural roots shaped his career. After earning a communications degree from Hamline University in 1998, he obtained his real estate license and co-owns Fladeboe Land, specializing in farmland transactions.

Glen lives in Minneapolis with his wife and two daughters. He enjoys marathon running, hunting, driving tractors, and relaxing at his cabin on Lake Superior's south shore.

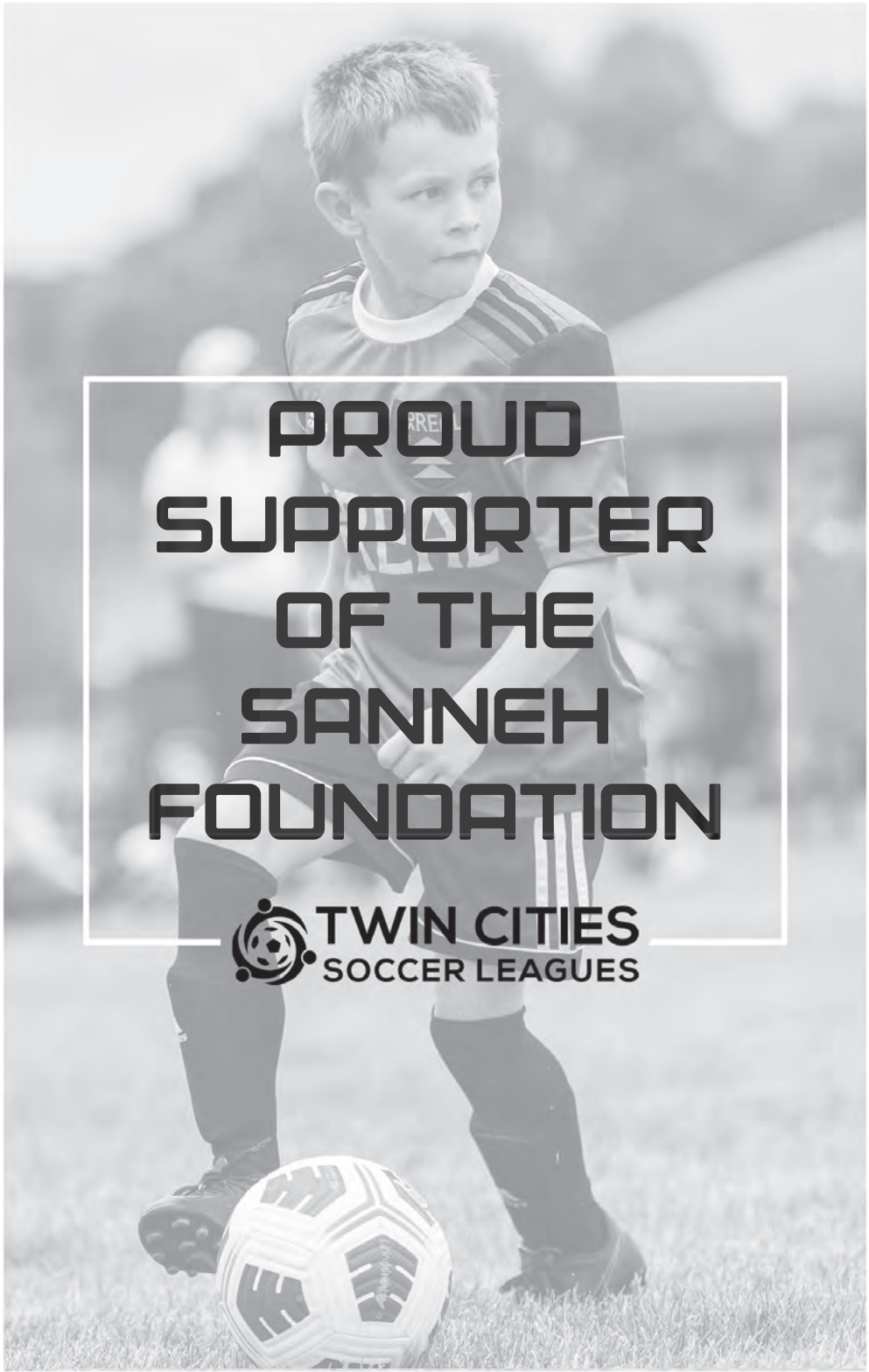
